Responsibilities

- To teach students, carry out methodological work, conduct research and experimental (social, cultural) development.
- To contribute to the implementation of the goals, objectives and values of the University defined in the Statute of LSU and the Strategy of the Development through the activities and work directly related to the position held.
- To follow the latest scientific and technological achievements, analyse the possibilities of their implementation in the study process at the University as well as in the main research areas, actively participate in dealing with academic problems.
- To contribute to the increase of the University prestige.
- To provide reports on scientific and pedagogical activity, other reports and reporting information material following the instructions of the Rector or a person authorised by the Rector within the timeframe stated in the regulatory documents of the University.
- To comply with the requirements of the Code of Ethics.

Requirements:

- To comply with the qualification requirements specified in LSU Procedure on Attestation of Teaching Staff Members and Researchers and Organization of Competition to Fill the Positions.
- To speak at least one foreign language (English preferably) for professional communication.
- After signing the employment contract, the Rector shall take decisions concerning permission to work in other academic and research institutions in accordance with Resolution No. 1043 of 19 August 2003 of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania "Features of an Employment Contract for Secondary Employment".

Additional requirements related to research and study areas:

- research area: physical education and well-being; study area: sociology of sport and health - 1 position
- research area: physical education and well-being; study area: physical education – 1 position
- research area: sports injury prevention; study area: baseball – 1 position
- research area: optimization of artistic gymnastics training; study area: artistic gymnastics – 1 position
- research area: athletic training for young athletes; study area: health, personal trainer – 1 position
