

When joining the course you will learn:

- To enhance your physiotherapy knowledge and skills in health technology and
- digitalisation in a rapid changing world.
- To enhance skills for process work.
- To evaluate health variables using health technology and digitalisation.
- To create novel methods to motivate elderly people from different backgrounds to enhance their physical functioning, activity and participation.
- To apply innovative methods in the creating and applying novel health technology for physiotherapy interventions

At the end of the course you will have deep understanding of the resources and problems by aging and competences in creating and applying technology- and digital solutions in physiotherapy promotion and prevention.

Teaching / learning methods

Contact lessons; digital platforms; project work in small international groups; study visit and workshop at technology-center; practical implementation, digital solutions, use of technology.

Pre course task

In international groups, the pre-course task has to be done using a digital platform.

The content of the pre course task will focus on

- exploring existing innovative solutions which improve quality of life and physical activity for healthy aging
- discuss the level of evidence of the findings
- short presentation of pre course tasks by the groups

Beside this

- Each student must prepare a 1 minute presentation of her/himself
- Each country group must prepare a 3 minutes presentation of your Physiotherapy Education and cultural issues in your country.
