





What is ERASMUS?




ERASMUS is the EU's educational mobility programme, designed to “*support education, training, youth and sport in Europe*”.

What does ERASMUS offer for the LSU student?



An opportunity to spend part of your study period abroad in another European (and not only) University or organization.



ERASMUS+ Programme:

Types of Mobility



Studies

- **Duration of a single mobility: from 3 to 12* months**
 - Over 80 foreign partner institutions



Traineeship

- **Duration of a single mobility: from 2 to 12* months**
 - Traineeship can also take place during the summertime
 - Traineeship is carried out in a selected organisation or enterprise



Recent graduate traineeship (only for KA103)

- **Duration of a single mobility: from 2 to 12* months**
 - You must apply while still being enrolled in the University
 - Traineeship must take place within one year after your graduation

** Total time abroad (incl. study abroad periods) may not exceed 12 months within one study cycle*



Mobility of individuals within Europe (Erasmus Programme Countries)









Student Selection for Erasmus

- Announcement of the call for student applications
- Submission of application through the LSU information system: is.lsu.lt
- Candidate's interview with the selection commission
- Announcement of selection results
- Completion of mobility documents



Student Selection Criteria

- Academic performance

- Academic performance of the last two terms or, for Master's and PhD first-year students, academic performance from a lower study cycle.

- Linguistic preparation

- Level of linguistic proficiency skills in the language of instruction at the host institution (not less than B1).

- Study/traineeship programme

- Study or traineeship programme and conditions offered by the host institution.

- Student's motivation

- Student's motivation to participate in the Programme and to study abroad.


- Student's self-sufficiency

- Student's problem-solving skills.

- Involvement in research, sports, volunteering and/or mentoring activities


