- To provide reports on scientific and pedagogical activity, other reports and reporting information material following the instructions of the Rector or a person authorised by the Rector within the timeframe stated in the regulatory documents of the University.
- To comply with the requirements of the Code of Ethics.

Workload: The exact scope is determined every academic year in accordance with the Procedure on Planning and Recording of University Teachers' Workload, approved by the Senate.

Requirements:

- To comply with the qualification requirements specified in LSU Procedure on Attestation of Teaching Staff Members and Researchers and Organization of Competition to Fill the Positions.
- To speak at least one foreign language (English preferably) for professional communication.

Additional requirements related to research and study areas:

- research area: Neuro-muscular rehabilitation; study area: Physiotherapy – 1 position
