



SENDIt teach workshop 2 on digital technologies in physical education for early childhood education and physical education teachers in the Faculty of Rehabilitation at the Jozef Pilsudski University of Physical Education in Warsaw (AWF Warsaw), 13.12.2023

Participants: 30 ECE & PE teachers

At AWF Warsaw, as part of the SENDIt teach project, 30 early childhood education (ECE) and physical education (PE) teachers from the province of Masovia participated in workshops on digital technologies in the practice of teachers supporting PE students with special educational needs. It started calmly with a theoretical introduction about the project itself, the results of

focus group interviews, the digital skills assessment and self-efficacy of ECE and PE teachers, the applications for PE classes, teaching strategies for inclusive PE, and motor literacy. After lunch, the workshop was moved to the gym, in the practical part, where the MULTIBALL system unleashed unprecedented levels of joy, creativity, and fun among the participants simulating various special needs. Elements of boccia for pupils with physical disabilities were used for the demonstration of applications presented during the theoretical part of the workshop. The same was done with elements of goalball for pupils with visual impairments. In the end, participants achieved certificates and shared their opinions about the workshop in the online survey.
