REGULATION ON STUDENT GROUPS WITH FEWER OPPORTUNITIES

In accordance with the LSU Procedure for Organisation and Implementation of Student Mobility for Studies and Placement, I hereby approve the list of student groups with fewer opportunities. Students belonging to these groups shall be eligible to receive additional grants when participating in Erasmus+ mobility projects upon submitting required documents detailed hereafter:

1. Students who are eligible for or receive social assistance under the Law of the Republic of Lithuania on Cash Social Assistance for Poor Residents or an equivalent law of the country of citizenship. Documents to be submitted: a document certifying the social assistance received or an equivalent document(s) from the Republic of Lithuania (in case of incoming mobility – document from student's country of citizenship)
2. Students with recognised disability as established by law. Documents to be submitted: a disability certificate.
3. Students who are no older than 25 years of age and who were placed under guardianship (care) in accordance with the procedure established by law before reaching the age of majority, or whose parents (or sole parent) are deceased. Documents to be submitted: death certificate(s) of sole parent (or parents), student's birth certificate, court decisions and other documents confirming the establishment of guardianship (care).
4. Students who are parents or guardians, raising a child (under 7 years of age) or a child with a disability (under 14 years of age). Documents to be submitted: birth certificate(s) of the child(ren), disability certificate(s), certificate of the declared place of residence in Lithuania of the child(ren) and the student (father/mother), (in case of incoming mobility – document from student's country of citizenship)
5. Students with refugee status. Documents to be submitted: Decision of the Migration Department of the Ministry of the Interior of the Republic of Lithuania on granting refugee status.
6. Ukrainian citizens coming to LSU under the Erasmus+ mobility programme, when the sending institution is a Ukrainian higher education institution. This clause shall remain valid for as long as it remains in force in the "Guidelines for the Implementation of Erasmus+ Project Activities for Persons Affected by the War in Ukraine" prepared by the Education Exchanges Support Foundation, a Lithuanian National Agency. Documents to be submitted: a copy of Ukrainian citizen's passport.

Students wishing to be assigned to a student group with fewer opportunities must submit an application and a document (or documents) proving their belonging to one of the specified groups to the International Relations Office of the Lithuanian Sports University no later than one (1) month before the start of mobility.

I hereby declare the Regulation No. SP-22, dated 14 February 2023, On Student Groups With Fewer Opportunities null and void.
