The **aim** of the conference – to broaden and deepen students’ knowledge and to encourage academic research.

The conference will be held on Thursday, **May 14, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.**

The value of the conference for students:

1. students who attend the conference will receive certificates of participation (their academic supervisors will be awarded certificates of appreciation from LSU);
2. abstracts of the participants’ presentations will be published in a special conference publication;
3. when applying for a master’s programme at LSU, students will receive 0.2 additional points (for scientific activity) for a presentation delivered at this conference;
4. an opportunity to get involved in the LSU Student Scientific Society.

The topics of the conference:

- Social and educational aspects of physical education and sport;
- Coaching technologies;
- Physical activity and health;
- Rehabilitation and sport physiology;
- Tourism and sport management.

Terms and conditions for participation in the conference

The conference is open to undergraduate students from all Lithuanian and foreign higher education institutions who submit abstracts in Lithuanian or English. In addition to their abstracts, participants (except for LSU students) must submit a copy of a document certifying that they are undergraduate students at a higher education institution.

The conference’s Scientific Committee reviews the submitted abstracts to determine whether they meet the specified requirements and informs the authors of their eligibility or ineligibility to present them at the conference.

Papers that have already been presented at other academic conferences may not be presented at this conference. The submitted abstracts must also not have been previously published.

The abstracts must be submitted by **12:00 p.m. May 4, 2026**. Please submit your abstract to the following email address: smd.konferencija@lsu.lt

Presentation guidelines

The presentation can last up to ten minutes, with five minutes allocated to discussion. The presenter will also be required to answer questions from the conference's Scientific Committee.

The conference will be held in **Lithuanian or English**. Captions for visual aids (tables, figures) may also be provided in Lithuanian or English.

Abstract guidelines

The abstracts must be prepared using the Lithuanian or English abstract template provided (based on the language of the abstract).

This is a public event, thus photography and videography will take place, and the footage will be made public.
